junior school and the senior school.

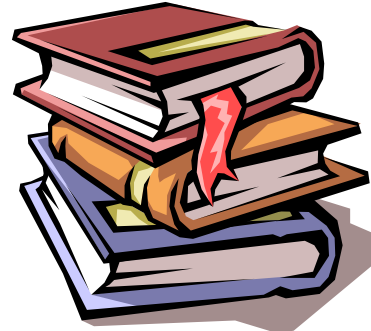
At this time, we will commence with a junior camp. The juniors are going to benefit from 3 days away living in touch with nature at Jamshedpur. You will receive notices
